

Kensington 4pc Seating Loveseat

Identify all parts packed in carton against the parts list. Remove all protective materials, place parts on a nonabrasive surface to avoid scratching. If any parts are missing or damaged, DO NOT attempt to assemble. Step 1

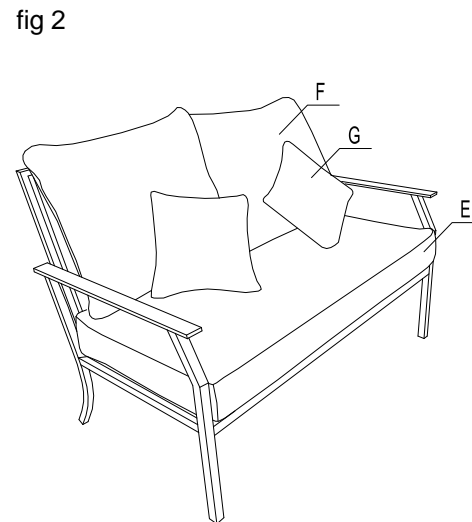
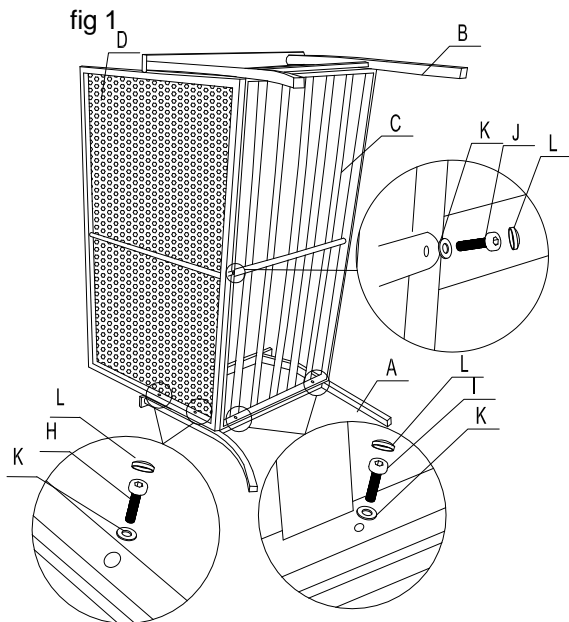
Attach the left and right chair arms (A&B) to the chair back (D), using the four Allen bolts (H) and metal washers (K). Do not tighten completely. fig 1

Step 2














Attach the left and right chair arms (A&B) to the chair seat (C), using the four Allen bolts (I) and metal washers (K). Attach the middle of chair back (D) to the middle back of chair seat (C) using the Allen bolt (J) and metal washer (K). Using the Allen wrench (M), tighten each bolt a few revolutions at a time in a cross x pattern to insure stability. Cover the bolts with the plastic bolt caps (L). fig1

Step 3

Place the seat and back cushions (E&F) and pillow (G) on the loveseat. Your loveseat is ready for use. fig 2
