



EASY

MEASUREMENTS

To fit kitchen sponge 2¼" [5.5 cm] wide x 3¼" [8.5 cm] long x 1" [2.5 cm] deep.

GAUGE

20 sts and 32 rows = 4" [10 cm] in Seed St Pat.

INSTRUCTIONS

Striped Version (Make 2 pieces alike)

With A, cast on 17 sts.

1st row: (RS). *K1. P1. Rep from * to last st. K1.

Last row forms Seed St Pat.

Cont in pat, working 2 rows each with A and B work from beg measures 4¼" [12 cm]. Cast off in pat.

Solid Version (Make 2 pieces alike)

Work as given for Striped Version, omitting all references to color changes.

Finishing

With WS facing, sew around 3 side edges using whip stitch. Insert Sponge.

Sew rem edge closed.

MATERIALS

Lily® Sugar'n Cream® (Solids: 2.5 oz/70.9 g; 120 yds/109 m;

Ombres: 2 oz/56.7g; 95 yds/86 m)

Striped Version

Contrast A Hot Orange (01628) **1 ball**

Contrast B Hot Blue (01742) **1 ball**

Solid Version 1 Psychedelic Ombre (02600) **1 ball**

Solid Version 2 Blueberry (01725) **1 ball**

Size U.S. 7 (4.5 mm) knitting needles **or size needed to obtain gauge.**
